

Funding as an Ecosystem

Pathway	What It Means	Consider
Federal and State Programs	NSF, DOE, EPSCoR, NASA, GOED, E-RISE, etc. Core funding that drives discovery and infrastructure.	Could two or three institutions co-write a proposal that builds shared capacity or training opportunities?
Industry Partnerships	Collaboration with companies focused on innovation, technology, or workforce development.	What challenge could your research help solve for a local or regional company?
Philanthropy / Foundations	Funders like Simons, Sloan, Heising-Simons, or Chan Zuckerberg Initiative (CZI) who support visionary or community-based science.	What story or outcome would inspire a philanthropic partner?
Advocacy and Policy Alignment	Visibility with Regents, GOED, legislators, or regional economic groups to raise awareness and alignment.	Who could advocate for your project and help it gain visibility?
Shared Resources	Leveraging SURF's facilities, university labs, and student training programs to enhance proposals.	How can SURF host, convene, or connect partners to make this idea more fundable?


