Outdoors:

- ❖ Mickelson Trail
 - This trail has an in-town trailhead, accessible at the Lead Railroad Spur, otherwise Kirk and Sugarloaf trailheads are nearby.
 - Further Mickelson Trail access in Deadwood.
 - There are use fees, and passes can be purchased at the trailhead or at the Forest Service office on Nevada Gulch Road.
- ❖ Homestake Trail
 - There is a trailhead by the Lead city dog park (just off Washington Street), or you can add .5 mile and start at VC.
- ❖ Gold Run Interpretive Park Trail
 - Just off Enos Street on Highway #85 between Lead and Deadwood.

Further afield:

- ❖ Spearfish Canyon
 - The Canyon boasts a beautiful drive, waterfalls and multiple trails, along with eateries at both Cheyenne Crossing and the Latchstring.
